Whitman County has received 37 new positive COVID-19 test results over the weekend and today, bringing the County total, to date, to 2938. All other cases are stable and self-isolating.

The eastern region must meet all 4 metrics in order to move into the next phase.

Whitman County will now be reporting the number of deaths and hospitalizations according to the Washington State Department of Health, rather than local tracking methods used previously. Number of “currently hospitalized” residents will no longer be reported. Using the state reported information is a clearer picture of the actual data because it will also reflect Whitman County residents that have been hospitalized or died outside of the county. The numbers in today’s report will reflect deaths not previously counted by Whitman County. Whitman County is in the process of COVID-19 vaccine administration in partnership with local area providers.
