Whitman County has received 9 new positive COVID-19 test results today, bringing the County total to 1412. 6 males between the ages of 20-39. 1 male between the ages of 40-59. 1 male between the ages of 60-79. 1 female over the age of 80. 2 cases are currently hospitalized. All other cases are stable and self-isolating.

Outbreaks reported include: WSU Greek Housing (107 cases), WSU Dorms (22 cases), Long Term Care Facilities: (6 facilities, 18 cases), School (1 school, 5 cases), and Other (1 facility, 3 cases).

Current COVID-19 activity highlights the need for individuals to maintain social distancing and personal vigilance. Masks are an easy and effective way to reduce the spread of COVID-19.
