Whitman County has received 27 new positive COVID-19 test results today. Upon further investigation, 1 previously counted case was transferred to another county so the Whitman County total is 1484. New cases include: 3 females and 3 males between the ages of 0-19, 6 females and 4 males between the ages of 20-39, 5 females between the ages of 60-79, and 5 females and 1 male over the age of 80. 3 cases are currently hospitalized. There has been 1 death which was previously reported on October 6, 2020. All other cases are stable and self-isolating.

Current COVID-19 activity highlights the need for individuals to maintain social distancing and personal vigilance. Masks are an easy and effective way to reduce the spread of COVID-19.
