Whitman County has received 31 new positive COVID-19 test results today, bringing the County total to 1590. New cases include: 6 females and 8 males between the ages of 0-19, 4 females and 9 males between the ages of 20-39, 3 females and 1 male between the ages of 40-59. 3 cases are currently hospitalized. All other cases are stable and self-isolating.

Current COVID-19 activity highlights the need for individuals to maintain social distancing and personal vigilance. Masks are an easy and effective way to reduce the spread of COVID-19.
