Whitman County has received 24 new positive COVID-19 test results today, bringing the County total to 1614. New cases include: 2 females and 4 males between the ages of 0-19, 6 females and 2 males between the ages of 20-39, 2 males between the ages of 40-59. 5 females and 1 male between the ages of 60-79, and 1 female and 1 male over the age of 80. 3 cases are currently hospitalized. There has been 1 new death reported today (a male over the age of 80), bringing the total deaths to 4. All other cases are stable and self-isolating.

Current COVID-19 activity highlights the need for individuals to maintain social distancing and personal vigilance. Masks are an easy and effective way to reduce the spread of COVID-19.
