Whitman County has received 49 new positive COVID-19 test results over the weekend and today, bringing the County total to 1403. 10 females and 11 males between the ages of 0-19. 9 females and 10 males between the ages of 20-39. 2 females between the ages of 40-59. 2 females and 2 males between the ages of 60-79. 1 female and 2 males are over 80 years old. 2 cases are currently hospitalized. No deaths. All other cases are stable and self-isolating.

Outbreaks reported include: WSU Greek Housing (107 cases), WSU Dorms (22 cases), Long Term Care Facilities: (6 facilities, 18 cases), School (1 school, 5 cases), and Other (1 facility, 3 cases).
