Whitman County has received 48 new positive COVID-19 test results yesterday and today, bringing the County total to 1986. New cases include: 1 female and 6 males between the ages of 0-19, 20 females and 9 males between the ages of 20-39, 2 females and 5 males between the ages of 40-59, 4 males between the ages of 60-79, and 1 female over the age of 80. 1 new death reported (1 male over the age of 80), bringing the County total to 21. 5 cases are currently hospitalized. All other cases are stable and self-isolating.

Current COVID-19 activity highlights the need for individuals to maintain social distancing and personal vigilance. Masks are an easy and effective way to reduce the spread of COVID-19.
