Whitman County has received 24 new positive COVID-19 test results today, bringing the County total, to date, to 2010.

1 new death reported today (1 male between the ages of 40-59), bringing the County total, to date, to 22. 5 cases are currently hospitalized. All other cases are stable and self-isolating.
