Whitman County has received 57 new positive COVID-19 test results over the weekend and today, bringing the County total, to date, to 2067. 3 cases are currently hospitalized. All other cases are stable and self-isolating.

The Whitman County Public Health COVID-19 webpage is changing. Data dashboard will reflect total cases as of date last updated, current hospitalizations, hospitalizations to date, and deaths. We will no longer report positivity rate. New data will include cases per 100k population over 2 week period, updated each Monday. The current pie chart assessing COVID-19 risk of spread will be replaced with a COVID-19 Activity level indicator that will be consistent with the State Department of Health metrics. This metric will be adjusted if the state changes their metrics. Such changes will take place beginning Tuesday 11/17/2020.
