Whitman County has received a total of 8 positive COVID-19 test results. All patients are stable and self-isolating. Patient 7 is a female aged 50-59 years. Patient 8 is a female aged 30-39 years. Public Health Department is investigating close contacts of the most recent positive patients. More information to follow as available.

Whitman County has received a limited supply of Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) which has been distributed to medical providers and first responders.
