Whitman County has received four new positive COVID-19 test results, which brings the County total to 70. Case #67 and #68 are both males between the ages of 20-39 years old. Case #69 is a female between the ages of 20-39 years old. Case #70 is a female between the ages of 40-59 years old. All cases are stable and self-isolating.

Current COVID-19 activity highlights the need for individuals to maintain social distancing and personal vigilance. Masks are an easy and effective way to reduce the spread of COVID-19.
