Whitman County has received forty-nine new positive COVID-19 test results, bringing the County total to 261. New cases include seven females and one male between the ages of 0-19, seventeen females and twenty-three males between the ages of 20-39, and one male between the ages of 40-59. All are stable and self-isolating.

Current COVID-19 activity highlights the need for individuals to maintain social distancing and personal vigilance. Masks are an easy and effective way to reduce the spread of COVID-19.
