Whitman County has received nine new positive COVID-19 test results. Seven out of the nine are female and two are male. Two females are between the ages of 0-19, four are between the ages of 20-39, and one is between the ages of 40-59. One male is between the ages of 0-19 and one is between the ages of 60-79. All are stable and self-isolating. This brings the County to a total of 114 cases with 42 of them being in the last two weeks. 37% of the cases are non-Pullman residents.

Current COVID-19 activity highlights the need for individuals to maintain social distancing and personal vigilance. Masks are an easy and effective way to reduce the spread of COVID-19.
