

Whitman County has received 43 new positive COVID-19 test results, bringing the County total to 913. New cases include 6 females and 9 males between the ages of 0-19. 14 females and 13 males between the ages of 20-39. 1 male between the ages of 40-59. All are stable and self-isolating.

In the last 3 weeks, Whitman County has reported 4 outbreaks in congregate settings to the Washington State Department of Health. These include Greek Housing, WSU Dorms, Long Term Care and one other congregate setting.

Whitman County is currently experiencing a delay in receiving lab results, which has artificially reduced our local numbers and we are working diligently to resolve the issue.



Current COVID-19 activity highlights the need for individuals to maintain social distancing and personal vigilance. Masks are an easy and effective way to reduce the spread of COVID-19.
