Whitman County has received 79 new positive COVID-19 test results today and over the weekend, bringing the County total to 1054. New cases include 12 females and 8 males between the ages of 0-19. 23 females and 34 males between the ages of 20-39. 1 male between the ages of 40-59. 1 female between the ages of 60-79. All are stable and self-isolating.

Current COVID-19 activity highlights the need for individuals to maintain social distancing and personal vigilance. Masks are an easy and effective way to reduce the spread of COVID-19.
