Whitman County has received 21 new positive COVID-19 test results today, bringing the County total to 1112. New cases include 5 females and 5 males between the ages of 0-19. 4 females and 6 males between the ages of 20-39. 1 male between the ages of 60-79. 1 previously reported positive person is currently hospitalized. All others are stable and self-isolating.

Current COVID-19 activity highlights the need for individuals to maintain social distancing and personal vigilance. Masks are an easy and effective way to reduce the spread of COVID-19.
