Whitman County has received 59 new positive COVID-19 test results from this last weekend and today, bringing the County total to 1171. New cases include 18 females and 10 males between the ages of 0-19. 12 females and 17 males between the ages of 20-39. 1 female between the ages of 40-59. 1 female between the ages of 60-79. 1 previously reported positive person is currently hospitalized. All others are stable and self-isolating.
