Whitman County has received 12 new positive COVID-19 test results today, bringing the County total to 1551. New cases include: 1 female and 1 male between the ages of 0-19, 5 females and 4 males between the ages of 20-39, and 1 female between the ages of 60-79. 2 cases are currently hospitalized, 11 have been hospitalized total to date. There has been 1 death reported today (1 male between the ages of 60-79), bringing the total deaths to 3. All other cases are stable and self-isolating.

Current COVID-19 activity highlights the need for individuals to maintain social distancing and personal vigilance. Masks are an easy and effective way to reduce the spread of COVID-19.
